

ELIGIBILITY FACTS

To start the eligibility process for services with Hocking County DD, an individual must have all of the following:

- Qualifying diagnosis: other than a diagnosis solely related to mental illness. (The diagnosis needs to be signed and dated by a licensed professional such as a Physician, Psychiatrist, School Psychologist) and be current, a year or less old.
- The diagnosis needs to have manifested by the age of 22.
(For individuals over 22 years of age, the diagnosis need not be current. However for example, if the diagnosis was mental retardation, further inquiry may be needed to determine the accuracy of the diagnosis and to see if more current information disputes the diagnosis. A new evaluation could be requested).
- The diagnosis is likely to continue indefinitely.
- The individual must reside in Hocking County.

After these conditions have been established, the next step in the eligibility process would be to administer a COEDI (Children's Ohio Eligibility Determination Instrument, for children age 6 through 16) or an OEDI (Ohio Eligibility Determination Instrument for individuals age 16 or over). The COEDI has 6 life skill areas and the OEDI has 7 life skill areas.

The areas include: self-care, receptive and expressive language, learning, mobility, self-direction, capacity for independent living.

(for an individual age 16 or older) capacity for economic self-sufficiency.

The individual would need to have a substantial functional limitation in 3 or more of the life skill areas to qualify for services.

Diagnosis definitions that are not accepted as a qualifying diagnosis on their own:

- Mentally Handicapped
- Developmental Delays
- Cognitive Delays
- Mental Retardation (needs to have a MR level re: mild, moderate, severe, profound)
- IQ levels

ADHD & ADD

With this diagnosis more information may be required to be determined qualifying:

- How does the diagnosis affect the individual's life?
- Does the individual need any therapies or special accommodations for learning?
- Is the diagnosis likely to continue indefinitely?

DIAGNOSIS GUIDELINES

Diagnosis Guidelines:

Acceptable diagnoses include but are not limited to:

AIDS, Amputation, Aphasia/Dysphasia, Attention Deficit Disorder, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder, Autism, Cancer, Cerebral Palsy, Clubfoot, Cystic Fibrosis, Down Syndrome, Epilepsy or Seizure Disorder, Hemiparesis, Hemophilia, Huntington's, Hydrocephalus, Juvenile Arthritis, Learning Disability (specify type, e.g., Auditory Decoding, Dyscalculia, Agraphia, Dyslexia), Lesh-Nyhan, Lung Disease, Mental Retardation (specify level), Muscular Dystrophy, Osteogenesis Imperfecta, Pervasive Developmental Disorder, Prader-Willi, Rett's Syndrome, Severe Cardiac and Circulatory Conditions, Sickle Cell Anemia, Spina Bifida, Spinal Cord Injury, Stroke, Tourette's Syndrome, Traumatic Brain Injury, Tuberculous Sclerosis, Usher's Syndrome, or other degenerative or neurological conditions.

Hearing and Vision Impairments are qualifying disabilities if the impairment equals or exceeds the standards established by the Ohio Department of Education's Rules For The Education Of Handicapped Children.

Unacceptable terms include but are not limited to:

Borderline Mental Retardation, Correctable Myopia, Developmentally Handicapped, Developmental Delay, Mild Hearing Loss, Multiple Handicapped, Orthopedically Handicapped, Severe Behavioral Disability, Slow Learner.

An individual who has a *sole diagnosis of mental illness* does not have a qualifying disability, and would not be eligible for a county board program. If, however, an individual has a qualifying disability (Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation, Traumatic Brain Injury, etc.) in addition to the mental illness, then he or she will satisfy this part of the FED.
